- Substance abuse testing and control programs

UEGCL already has ISO 9001 Quality Management System Certification, and is on track for ISO 45001 Health and Safety Management System and ISO 14001 Environment Management System Certification, but our emphasis for now is to ensure resilient health and safety systems and procedures for a safe work environment.

The overall responsibility for health and safety rests with the Chief Executive Officer. UEGCL has set up a Health and Safety Organization, with a structure as well as roles and responsibilities defined, for all projects and operations.
