



660 MW


Capacity. The hydropower plant will add 600Megawatts (MW) to the national grid. The 60 MW is for running the plant.



Shs6.2t

Cost. The Karuma HPP cost Shs6.2t of which Shs5.2t was a loan from China Exim Bank and Shs933b as government counterpart financing.

Location: The station lies about 75km south of the northern city of Gulu and 270km from the capital city, Kampala.
